National Night Out:

DPS Office:

Have you noticed an increased presence of DPS troopers in Caldwell County? Beginning in October 2017, we now have an office of seven troopers in the county. These officers will be patrolling roads and also serve as backup for local law enforcement. At this time an office has been established in Lockhart with plans to also open an office in Luling.

If you are interested in supporting our First Responders in the county, consider joining the Caldwell County Seniors and Law Enforcement Together (S.A.L.T.) Council. They meet on the last Monday of each month with alternating meetings in Luling and Lockhart. Next S.A.L.T. Council meeting will be held on October 29 at Luling City Hall at 10 am. CARTS Services in Caldwell County:

CARTS Community Transit service can help you when you need a ride for shopping, medical appointments, or other purposes. The

fares range from \$2 to \$6 depending on where you are traveling and half fare for seniors and persons with disabilities is available. To schedule your ride, call 1-800-456-RIDE. Rides are scheduled Monday through Friday from 7 am to 4 pm with 24 hour advance notice recommended. Call CARTS for additional routes outside the county.

Mailing & Copying Services:

We now have a new Pakmail store on Thorpe Lane handily located behind the big HEB in San Marcos. They can pack, crate, ship, and freight anything anywhere. They also offer copying, faxing, laminating, notary, passport photos, and moving materials. Bring your PDF file in a flash drive to their customer business center so they can facilitate your business in one speedy stop. They also accept all returns and pre-labeled packages at no cost to you.

New Medicare Cards:

New safer Medicare cards are being mailed to all 58 million Medicare clients during the next 12 months. Watch your mail for this important change! There is no charge for the new card or action required. Benefits will not change. Rather than your SS#, the number will be an MBI (Medicare Beneficiary Identifier). It will look something like this: IEG4- TES-MK72 example only). Guard your MBI card just as you did your old Medicare card. Share only with trusted health care providers. Do not put your MBI on emails or computer files, give it out over the phone, or routinely carry the card. Only carry it when you will need it.
